Classic, Vintage, and Antique

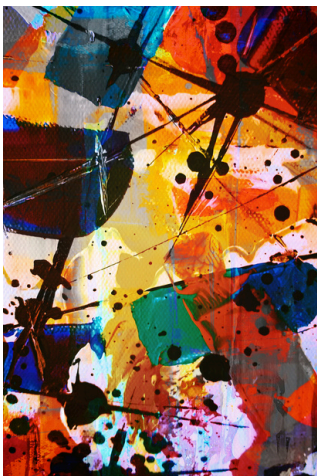
Today, Art is commonly highlighted for its aesthetic sense.

Art also allows us to respond to a need to externalize a feeling, an emotion or to "unload" it.

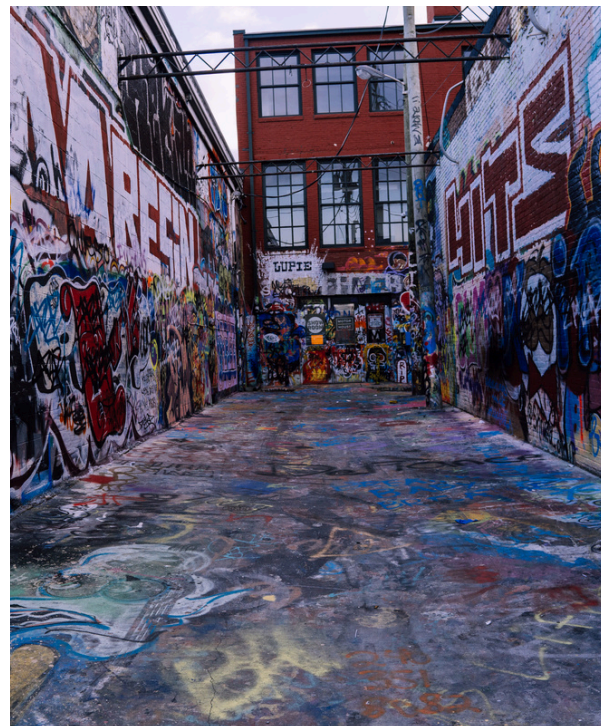
It connects us to our unconscious and our spirituality.
